Job Responsibilities:

- Organize and implement TB workshops in Clyde River
- Participate in creating/updating documents and tools related to help achieve project objectives
- Organize and deliver regular community programming including radio shows and community trainings
- Regular and ongoing engagement with local and territorial stakeholders (e.g. Supervisor of Community Health Programs, NTI, QIA and Territorial Hamlets and Health Committees) to build trust and help achieve project objectives
- Continue to advance the project's objectives, especially community-based solutions to ongoing threats from TB
- Additional activities and responsibilities as necessary to advance the goals of Ilisaqsivik

Job Requirements:

- Experience training/mentoring others
- Basic knowledge of tuberculosis (TB)
- Computer skills (e-mail, Microsoft Word/Excel, Teams, social networking, etc)
- Strong listening and communication skills including comfort with speaking on radio in fluent English and Inuktitut
- Demonstrate respect for diversity, cultural and individual
- Able to work independently, with good coordination between multiple teams
- Understanding of evidence-based medicine
- Understanding of data/information management
- Interest in information technology (I.T.) and innovation
- Experience working in the healthcare field is considered an asset

Salary and Benefits:
